BACKGROUND

The Trust has been operational for 18 months and in this time has established a strategic plan, operational policies and community programs. The governing committee and council of the Trust is now seeking to develop a communication strategy for the purpose of establishing internal as well as external communication protocols.

The Trust operates with four distinct internal stakeholders:
