In 2013 the K&M established the Kuruma Marthudunera Aboriginal Corporation (KMAC). KMAC monitors and implements obligations under K&M peoples' various participation agreements. KMAC is responsible for protecting and preserving K&M cultural heritage and utilises the Charitable Trust funds to deliver programs for the betterment of the K&M people.

There are approximately 290 adult members in the K&M community. The total population including spouses and family members likely to benefit from K&M programs is in excess of 700 people.
